

HOW TO SHARE THE VISION

Objective: Using Matthew 28:19-20, help the listener understand Christ's call to discipleship/multiplication & challenge them to heed the call.

Step 1: Define "disciple"

- A) Let them read Matthew 28:19-20 aloud.
- B) Ask, "*What does Jesus command?*" (to make disciples)
- C) Ask, "*How would you define the word disciple?*" (follower of Christ)
- D) Explain that a disciple will be strong in all 4 areas of "the wheel" (word, prayer, evangelism, fellowship.) Explain what each of these looks like in the life of a disciple. (ex. A disciple won't just read the Word once in a while, he/she will study it daily and even memorize verses.)

Step 2: The growth scale (C-----D-----DM)

- A) Draw C-----D. (Convert ----- Disciple)
- B) Explain that this is a growth line. Ask them where they are on the line in light of the definition of a disciple.
- C) Explain that Jesus commanded in verse 19 to make disciples. Explain that a DM is someone who helps C's become D's.
- D) Add -----DM (Disciplemaker)

Step 3: The challenge to multiply

- A) Ask, "*Why do you think Jesus wants people to be disciples and not just converts?*"
- B) Show the multiplication principle: 1000 C's/ year for 30 years = 30,000 C's vs. 30 years of multiplication = 1 Billion D's
- C) Ask, "*Where do you think God wants you to be on the growth line?*"
- D) Ask, "*What do you think it will cost you to get there?*" (time, priorities...)
- E) Tell your story of buying into this vision, the cost, and the benefits.
- F) Explain that a person must become a D before they can be a DM.
- G) Explain that you would be glad to let them know about some opportunities that could help them grow.
- H) Ask, "*Would you be interested in finding out about some of these opportunities?*" If yes, invite them to something. (i.e. Bible study, Kaleo, large group...)
